- Data Analysis and Probability

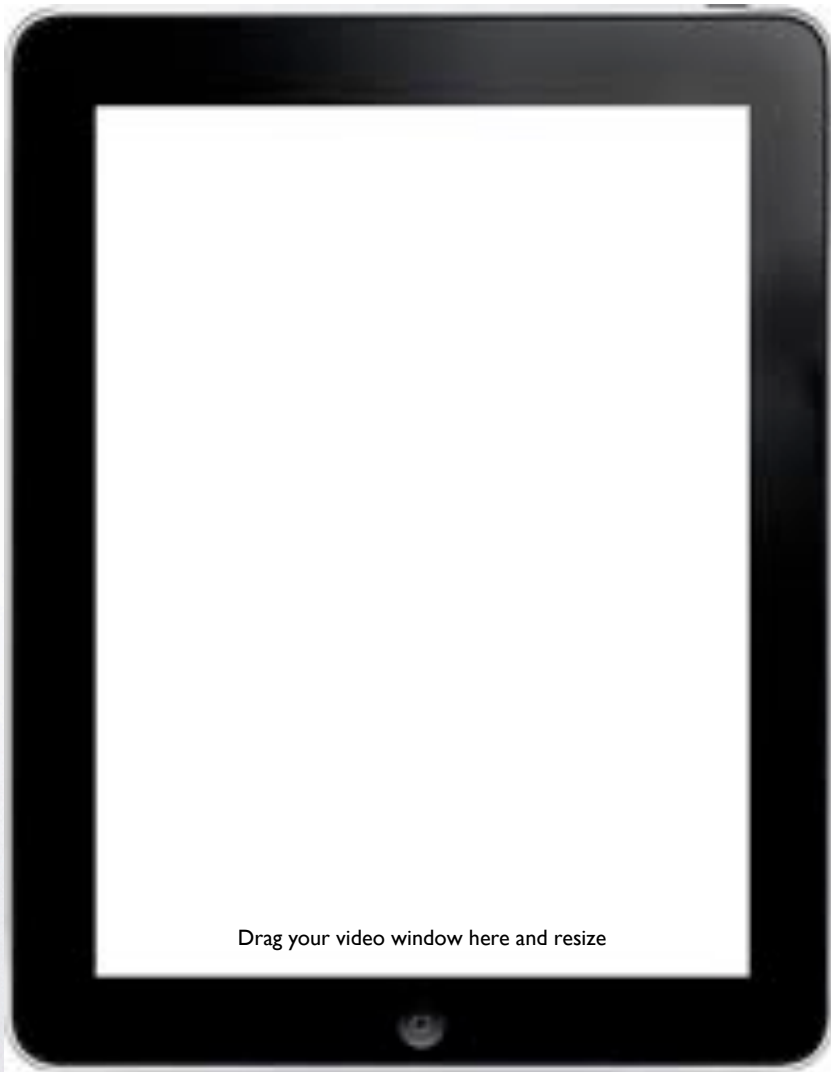
Shape Up!

- Four little cows – Bluebell, Violet, Rosie and Buttercup – bored of their square meadow, want to escape. To do so they will need help to remove the posts at the corners of the meadow.
- Draw shapes, in which children learn how to draw basic shapes and are rewarded with stamps of our little cows
 - Spot the Difference, that requires dexterity and care from the little fingers to complete.
- Assessment Idea: Check list (which shapes, on request, were they able choose and draw independently);

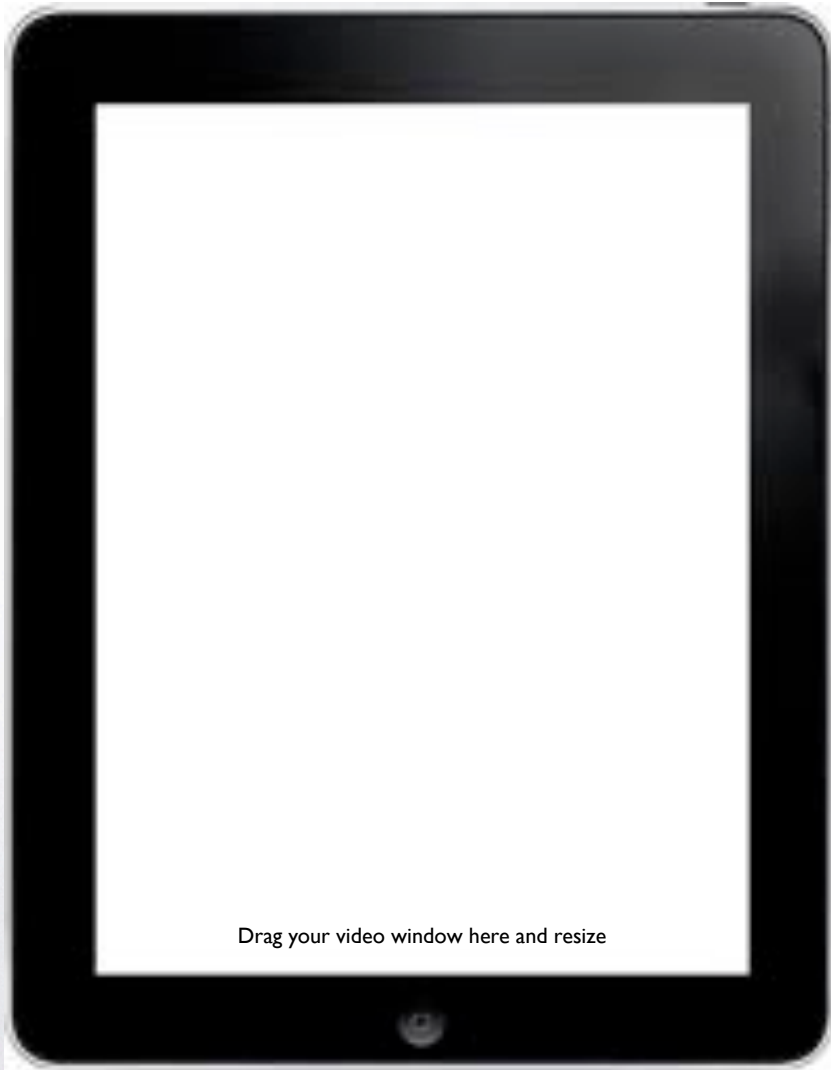
Autism Colors

- Discrete Trial Training
- Fully automated and has been tested with children with autism at The Children's Treatment Center
- Very simple with no distracting stimuli
- Not designed to be a general purpose game, but rather a clinically tested training approach for children with a specific type of disability.

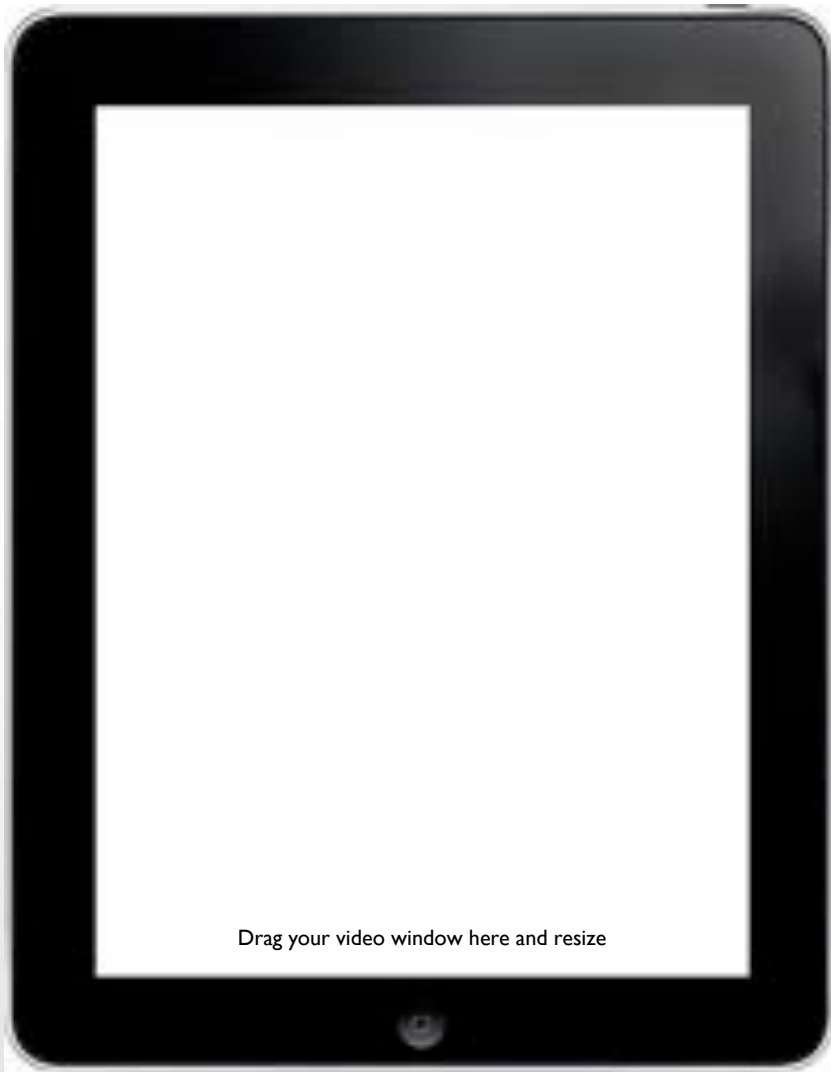
Alien Buddies

- Matching: color, shape, letter and number recognition (audio and visual modes)
- Visual and audio Matching games: the cast of cute and quirky characters will lead your child on an engaging journey to reinforce fundamental skills: *recognizing colors, shapes, numbers and uppercase and lowercase letters*
- Turn music/ sound effects on/of and reset completed games under “Parents” button

Clean Up: Category Sort

Free



- Students sort items, according to where they would be kept
- Assessment: Limit the number of objects, then use the percentage on the top right

Drawing Pad

- Primarily an art program
- Access “stamps”, which are easily moveable
- Student can sort them according to specific features, colour, etc.
- Save or email finished image

ABA- Problem Solving – What does not belong

Free



- Customizable: Voice, Images, Concepts
- Dynamic game play adjust difficulty automatically to keep kids both challenged and entertained. If you select progressive game play then the game starts with easy concepts (e.g. touch the circle) and proceeds to advanced concepts (touch the bigger circle) automatically.
- Implementation Idea: With a partner, students can discuss each item and decide which doesn't belong (noticing lines, colour, direction, etc.). The students could also discuss this with a teacher.
