

Autism Spectrum Disorder & the iPod Touch / iPad Feedback from parents, teachers & students...


- increased engagement in curricular related tasks
- •reduced anxiety when able to access calendar APPS, relax APPS and self regulation activities on the iPod Touch
- •improved expressive language (sideways keyboard, word prediction, ease of use, print magic, Dragon)
- •increased independent work skills
- •increased independent self regulation skills
- ease of use of learning and applying for teachers, parents and students

- •provided a means of portable communication for one student with ASD who is non verbal
- •affordable •portable
- •motivational device (iRewards use etc.) •enhancement of basic skills including math, science, language arts, ebook access, time, life skills, functional skills, social thinking and social skills)
- enhanced skills in scheduling
- enhanced skills in communicating and socializing and much more.



Visual Timer

- **√**.99¢
- √ Visual graphics display
- ✓ Drag to the desired time (up to 60 minutes)



iRewards: Motivation and Goal Setting

iRewards

- ✓ Easy to use rewards chart for children
- ✓ Type in their name

- ✓ Reward their accomplishments with a checkmark on a weekly chart
- ✓ Utilize with students with autism to work towards predetermined goals throughout a day or week, student or teacher checks off the task completion, email out reports to home or teachers





Rory's Story Cubes: Written Output, Idea Generation

- **√**\$1.99
- ✓ 9 cubes, 54 images offering an unlimited number of stories
- ✓ Shake the iPod Touch, roll the cubes and create a story based on the 9 images facing
- ✓ Snap a picture of the "deck" and send to photo library
- ✓ Use later to enhance the written document
- ✓ Copy/paste the image into DocstoGo or another writing App
- √ Fun, easy, engaging and motivating
- ✓ Utilize to motivate reluctant writers, spark imagination, enhance social skills, turn taking, verbal output, communication, creativity





Fluid2: Sensory



- ✓ Relaxation App
- ✓ Listen to water rippling over a background of your choice
- ✓ Change the backgrounds from your photo album
- ✓ 5 finger swipe to bring up settings
- ✓ Turn music on or off
- ✓ Throw a coin into the pond and make a wish
- ✓ Students with ASD find this App particularly engaging and relaxing
- ✓ Utilize for transition preparation to enhance relaxation and calm, reduce anxiety, preparation for the next task or enhance a calm state when a student is in a heightened state of arousal



CASE STUDY: Fluid 2

K is a young man in grade 7. K has involved autism, is non verbal, displays difficulties with motor planning, attention, engagement, social interaction, transitioning etc. K's program is focusing on developing functional skills. K historically would not sit, attend and engage with anything for more that 1 minute before the introduction of Fluid2 on the iPad. When using Fluid2 he will sit, relax and self regulate for 15+ minutes.

- ✓ Support students with autism who have graphomotor skill difficulties





Dragon: Written Output Support

- √ Voice to Text
- ✓ No training
- √ Fairly good recognition of voice
- ✓ Ability to correct with keyboard
- ✓ Must have firewall opened to Nuance server to work
- ✓ Email text to share
- ✓ Easy to use and apply (must have Wifi)
- ✓ Still must be able to formulate idea, plan, organize, sequence and articulate ideas verbally and have technical skills to use iPod Touch






